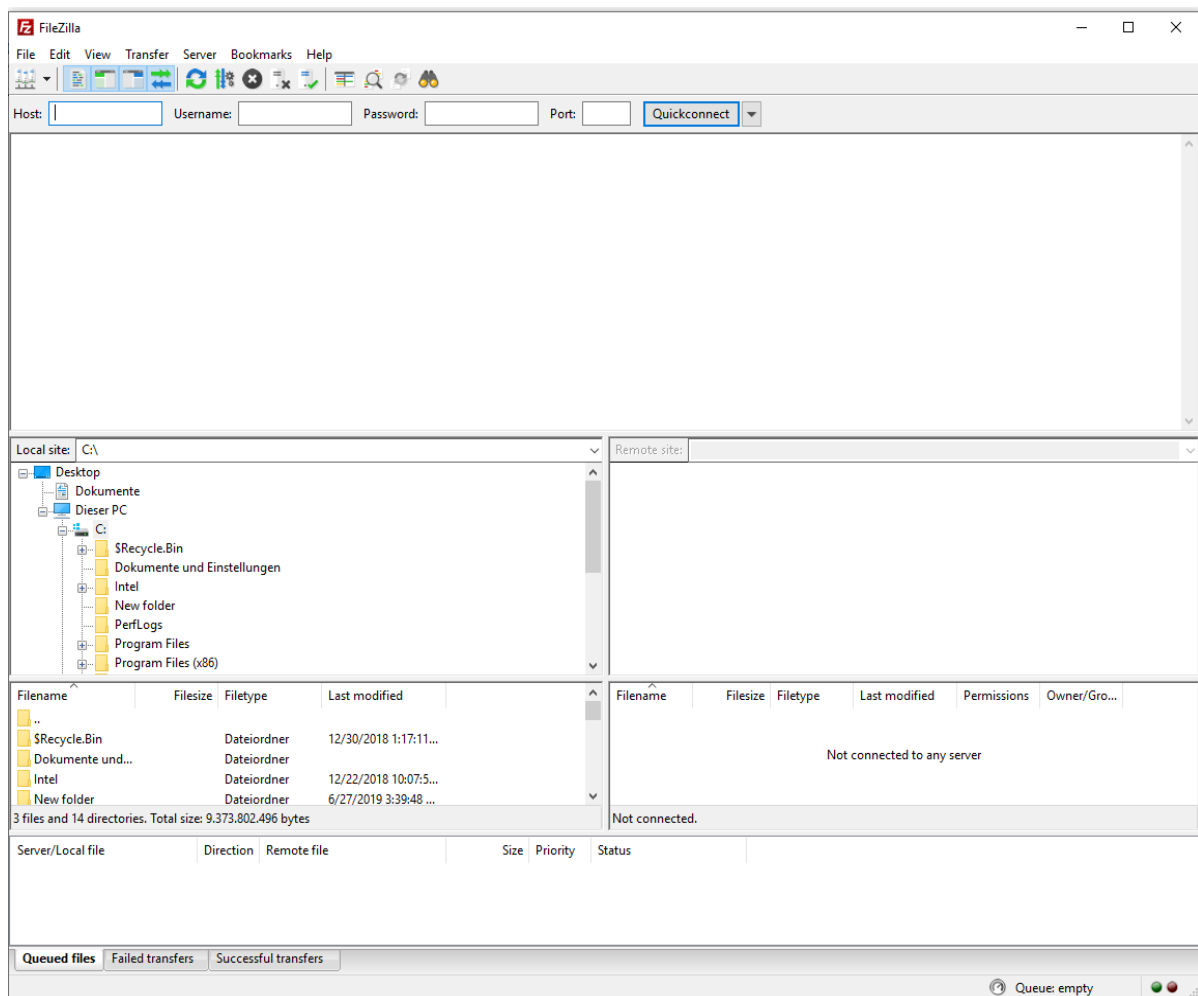

Download the latest version of the „FileZilla Client“ to your computer. You can use the following link to find the latest version: <https://filezilla-project.org/>


After downloading, install FileZilla to your computer.

By starting FileZilla, the following window opens:



On the left side of the program-screen you see the directory structure of your computer. In the right column you will find the directory structure of your webspace, after you've connected to the easyname webserver successfully.

In the top bar, you have to specify the login credentials of the easyname webserver. These can be found in your easyname control panel (<https://my.easyname.com>) by clicking on **[Web Hosting]** → **[FTP Accounts]**



Here you will find all of your FTP accounts.

By clicking on **[Edit]** (pen-icon, on the right side of the respective user), the hostname, the username and the server path (to which the user is restricted) will be displayed (see picture below).

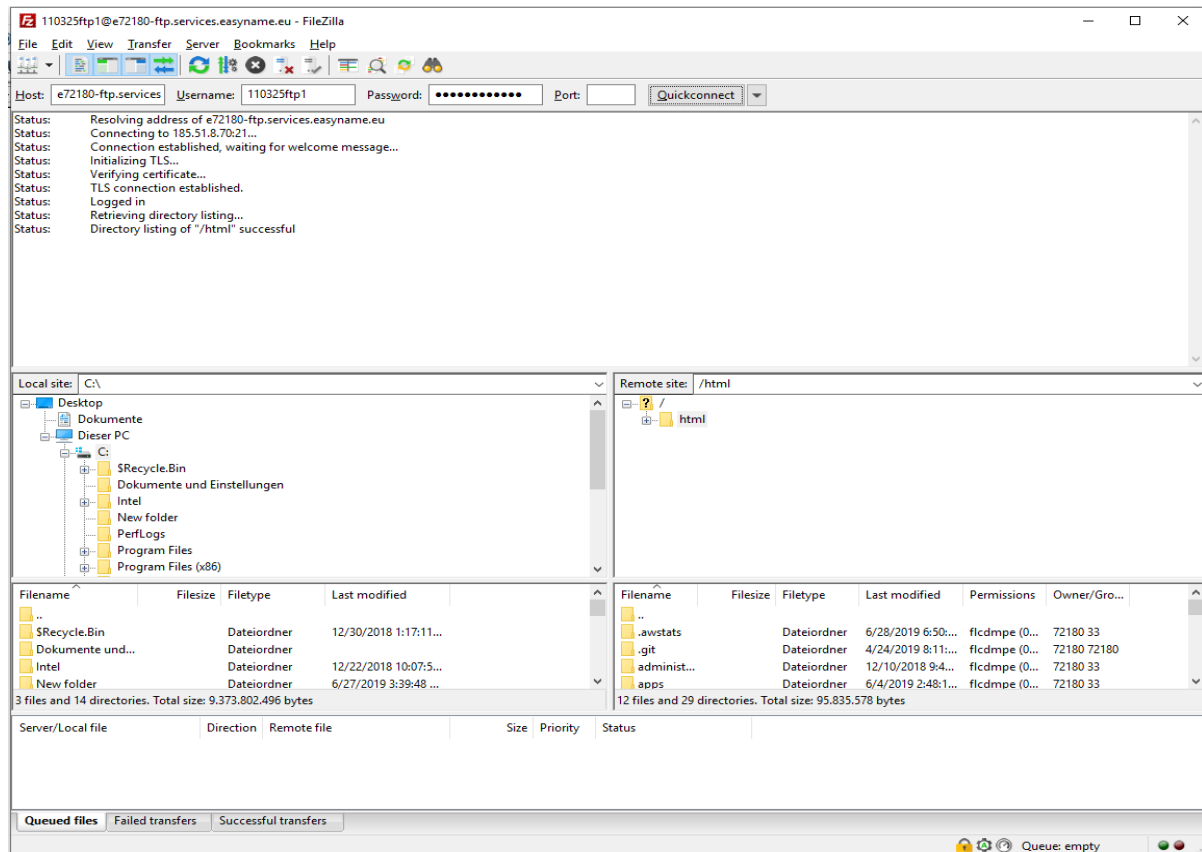

If you have never connected to the FTP-server before, please make sure that you set a new password first. This can be done by clicking on **[SET NEW PASSWORD]**

Should you have forgotten your password, you can reset it with the respective link.

Now copy the login information from the control panel and enter them into the top bar of FileZilla (see picture below). The „Hostname“ is the „Server“ and the field „Port“ can be left empty. After you've entered the required data click on **[Quickconnect]**



In the left column you have to navigate through the directory structure of your computer until you get to the folder where the data of your website are. Then select the entire content of this folder and drag them to the right side into the /html/-folder.

After this action all the selected files will be transferred to your webspace on easyname.


Once all data has been copied, you can close FileZilla.

Please note that the starting page of your website has to be named **index.html**, **index.htm** or **index.php**

Last but not least, you have to configure your subdomain-settings, so that the uploaded files can be displayed.

Login to your easyname control panel again (<https://my.easyname.com>) and click on **[Domains]** → **[Subdomains]** (next to the respective domain) → **[Edit]** (pen icon; see picture below)


If there is no entry for your subdomain click on **[Add a new subdomain]** → type "www" into the textfield → **[ADD]**

Finally, select **[Show webspaces content]** and enter a slash in the field „Path“ (see picture below) before clicking on **[Save]**. Now the webserver knows that the webcontent of the /html/-folder has to be published. If you have uploaded your files into a subfolder of the /html/-folder (e.g., /html/apps/), you will have to define this specific folder (e.g., /apps/).
